### # = Must Be Completed Within First 30 Credits

- Tier 1 Prerequisite required to be completed before taking Linked Tier 1 Category
- → One tier 1 Prerequisite required to be completed before taking Linked Tier 2 Category
- → → Tier 1 Prerequisite strongly encouraged before taking linked Tier 2 Category
- → → → Two Tier 2 Prerequisite categories to be completed before taking Tier 3 Capstone

++ All students must complete either a Tier 1 or Tier 2 Natural Science course (T1NS or T2NS) with a lab so that a total number of credits between T1NS and T2NS equals 7.

\* All Accounting transfer students must fill out in Column A for transfer credits completed and accepted at ECSU. Column B - for all credits completed at ECSU only.

\*\* A minimum of 24 credit hours of the Advanced Accounting Requirements must be completed at ECSU for the Accounting Major Degree. Students who do not meet this residency requirement because of transfer credits applied in the Advanced Accounting Requirements courses from the Advanced Accounting Electives to make up their deficiencies.

\*\*\* Students majoring in Accounting are required to take ECO 200 to satisfy LAC - T1SS and ECO 201 to satisfy LAC - T2IS, which will count both towards the respective LAC Tier 1 and Tier 2 categories and the Accounting major (in other words "Double Count"). Only those two courses may double count between LAC Tiers 1 and 2 and the Accounting major.

## To be finalized later: Courses gaining approval to be offered as LAC Tier 3 courses for the Accounting major will double count as both the LAC Tier 3 course for Accounting major students and as an Accounting major course for the student.

\*1 Students transferring 30+ credits to ECSU, if they have not taken an LAC-T1SS course prior to Fall 2009, they may take ECO 201 concurrently with an LAC-T1SS course by obtaining special permission from the Dept. of Economics.

\*2 Students transferring 30+ credits to ECSU, if they have not taken an LAC-T1M course prior to Fall 2009, they may take ECO 215 concurrently with an LAC-T1M course by obtaining special permission from the Dept. of Economics

**Additional Note:** Within the 120 credits required for the baccalaureate degree, 60 credits higher, and at least 30 of these credits must be at the 300-400 level.
