**New Students:**

After 2007 CSC100 will not be a prerequisite for BUS205 but students need to satisfy the LAC Technology Competency requirement (Tech-SETT).

**Transfer Students:**

Students who have evidence of having taken comparable courses elsewhere should provide a copy of the relevant catalog description, transcript, and course syllabus.

**Course Offering Guidelines:**

If a student cannot register for a course because it is full or needs a prerequisite, they can contact the instructor for permission to enroll.

The on-line June offerings in BUS 205 and BIS 370 and the summer offerings of BIS 361 and BUS 205 provide flexibility in the design of your course sequence. Some classes may be available via video conferencing at Groton.

BIS 364 and BIS 462 (BIS electives) will be offered online or in a face to face instruction mode after 2008 as specified in the above schedule. **By exception: BIS 461 is not offered in spring 2009.**

**Graduation Rules:**

Students who take a BIS minor cannot take a Social Informatics minor and vice versa.

Students majoring in BIS cannot have a BIS minor, MIS minor, Social Informatics minor or a certificate in BIS due to the university rule that a minor needs to have at least 9 credits distinct from a major progra

If some students plan to graduate before a certain course is offered, they may request the BIS coordinator's permission to take a similar course elsewhere by providing a catalog description of the substitute
