* Students majoring in Business are exempted from GER Category IA and IVB through successful completion of MAT 216, and ECO 200 or 201, respectively.

** All Students are required to have completed the GER: III.A-Math & V.A.-Writing components within their first 30 credit hours of enrollment.

OTHER NOTES: A minimum of 24 credit hours of the Business major must be completed at ECSU.

Within the 120 credits required for your degree, 60 credits must be numbered 200 or higher, and at least 30 of these credits must be at the 300-400 level.

Notes on Writing Intensive Courses:

- For first year students starting in Fall 2008 or later, the writing intensive course is BUS 301 - Business Ethics.

- For students starting college prior to fall 2008, the writing Intensive course is BUS 365 - Business Report Writing

- Due to course scheduling availability, a request to allow either BUS 301 or 365 to be taken as the writing intensive course for the Bus. Admin Major may be made to the Dept. chair.

*1 Students not having completed ECO 201 prior to Fall 2009 must complete an LAC- T1SS course prior to taking ECO 201 or if transferring in 30+ credits may obtain special permission to take them concurrently from the Economics Department

*2 Students not having completed MAT 216 or ECO 215 prior to Fall 2009 must complete one of the following math courses(MAT 130, 135, 139, or 243) prior to taking ECO 215 or MAT 216. Students transferring 30+ credits may obtain special permission to take one of these math courses concurrently with Eco 215 from the Economics Dept.

*3 Students not having completed BUS 205 prior to Fall 2009 must complete one of the following math courses (MAT 130, 135, 139, or 243) prior to taking BUS 205. Students transferring 30+ credits may obtain special permission to take BUS 205 concurrently with (Mat 130, 135, 139, or 243)
